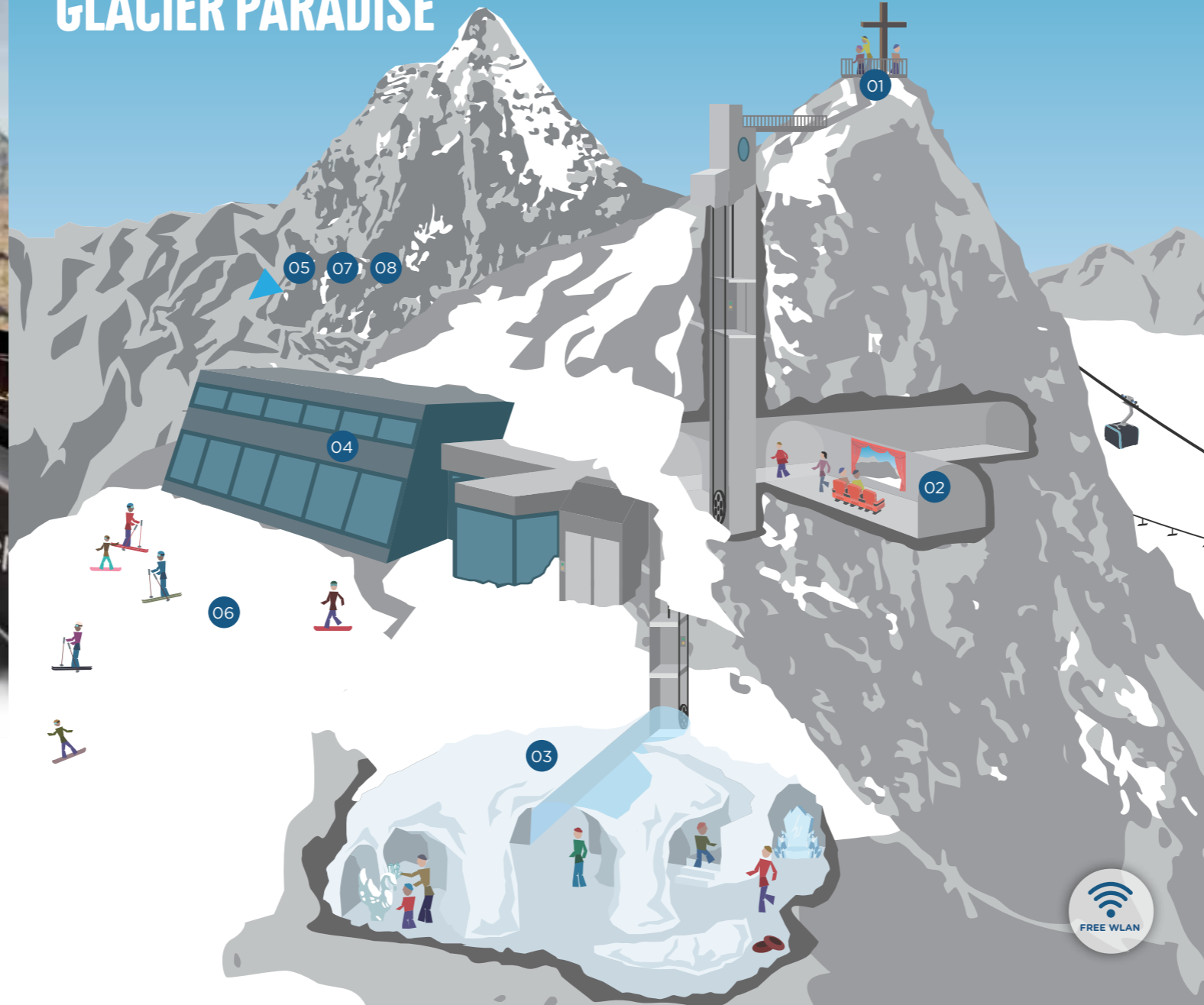

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WELCOME TO MATTERHORN GLACIER PARADISE

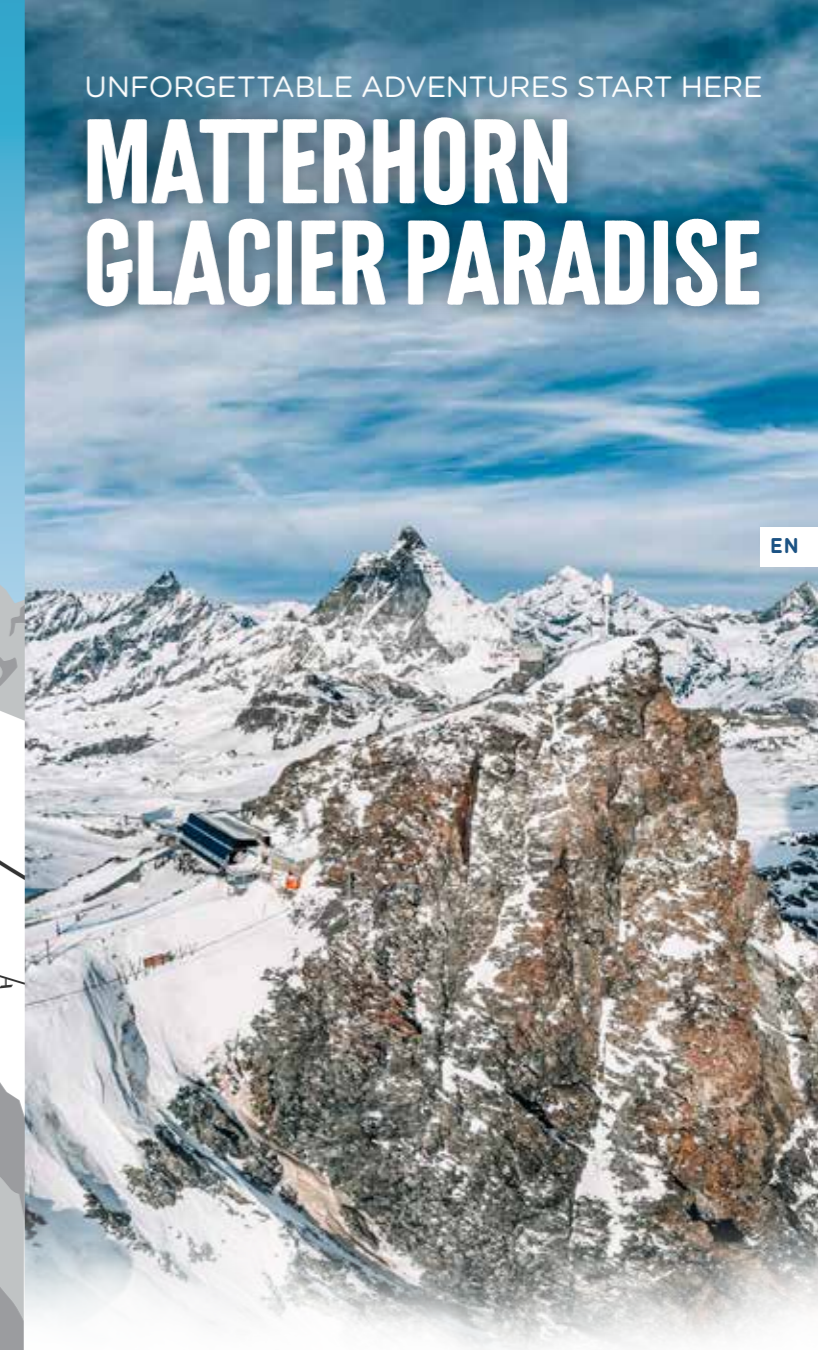
At a lofty 3'883 / 12'739 ft metres of altitude is Europe's highest aerial cablecar and mountain station. Want to go still higher? The summit lift will bring the guests up to the viewing platform, offering a 360° panoramic view that includes 38 Alpine giants. From the **highest viewing platform in Europe** visitors can enjoy a unique Alpine view that knows no national boundaries. The 360° panorama opens up over 38 four-thousanders and 14 glaciers in France, Italy and Switzerland. It's impossible to get enough of this view, which takes in the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau in the north, the craggy north face of the Breithorn in the east, and Mont Blanc, the highest peak in Europe, in the west. And the Matterhorn too can be seen from a different perspective. The long-distance view is captivating and instils a quiet, reflective mood in many visitors.

GLACIER PALACE

Step into the **highest glacier palace in the world**: a place of enchantment which will draw you into the fascinating world of eternal ice. Surrounded by painstakingly created ice sculptures and centuries-old ice formations, it's as if you have entered a magical fairy tale. You'll find it 15 metres below the surface: a fairytale world of glistening ice crystals, with an ice slide, a glacial crevasse you can walk along, and a number of photopoints. Even the walk into the palace is spectacular.

CRYSTAL RIDE

The **Matterhorn Glacier Ride I and II** are the highest 3S cableways in the world. They both feature one very special highlight: several exclusive **"Crystal Ride"** cabins decorated with crystals. Their true secret is only disclosed during the ride, however, when the darkened floors suddenly become transparent to reveal stunning views of the glacial landscape below. An amazing experience and one not to be missed!

MATTERHORN ALPINE CROSSING

Matterhorn Alpine Crossing: The cable car connection between Matterhorn Glacier Paradise and Testa Grigia is the realisation of a cross-generational dream: to travel all the way from the Matterhorn village of Zermatt (Switzerland) to Breuil-Cervinia (Italy) without getting your shoes wet!
The panoramic ride covers a difference in altitude of more than 4,000 metres, the greatest of any cable car in Europe.

CINEMA LOUNGE

The modern **Cinema Lounge** in the Breithorn tunnel provides untarnished entertainment for film buffs, presenting **fascinating footage** on the subjects of alpinism, the alpine world, and the flora and fauna, lifts and cable cars of the Zermatt region. It's the perfect way to get in the mood to enjoy the stunning views at 3'883 metres above sea level or a great activity for a rainy afternoon. Admission to the Cinema Lounge is free of charge.

Do you thought the mountains were taken over by hikers in the summer? Think again! In Europe's **highest and biggest glacier ski area** you can ski to your heart's content even in the summer season. In Zermatt hikers and skiers just share the mountains, it's as simple as that. Between Trockener Steg station at 2,929 metres and the Gobba di Rollin, the highest point on the Breithorn plateau at 3'899 metres, lies the summer ski area with up to 21 kilometres of slopes.

From your first snow experience to fast-paced snow tubing descents and your first skiing experience, the **SnowXperience Plateau Rosa** adventure park on Testa Grigia at the highest cable car border crossing in the Alps combines snow and fun for beginners and adventurers alike.
There is a rental station for skis, clothing, ski coaching and the meeting point for glacier trekking at the Testa Grigia station.
